We are pleased to announce that the 10th Conference of European Committee for Conservation of Bryophytes will be held in Zagreb, Croatia's capital, from 20 to 23 May 2020.

The Conference is organised by European Committee for Conservation of Bryophytes in cooperation with Croatian Botanical Society, Department of Biology and Botanical Garden of Faculty of Science, University of Zagreb.

On behalf of the Organizing Committee, we invite you to take part in the Conference, traditionally covering topics on conservation of bryophytes, important bryophyte areas, ecology, dispersal and habitats of threatened species, as well as *in situ* and *ex situ* conservation.

In two one-day excursions, the participants will have an opportunity to visit bryologically interesting areas that are among the most valuable in Croatia.

Venue ...

The conference will take place in Botanical Garden of the Department of Biology (www.botanickivrt.biol.pmf.hr/en/) located in the centre of the down town.

Abstracts submission ...

Submitted abstracts should be maximum 250 words long, written in one paragraph, in English, using Times New Roman, font size 12, without any formatting.

The participants will soon be able to submit abstracts by filling out the form on the official website of the Conference. Abstracts will be peer-reviewed and the decisions about the acceptance will be announced three weeks after the submission. Participants will be informed via e-mail.

All participants need to choose preferable way of presentation during the abstract submission process. In case of too many submitted oral presentations, the Organizing/Scientific Committee reserves the right to change the form to poster. In that case, the presenting author will be informed via e-mail about the Committees' decision.

Presenting authors (oral or poster) must register early and pay the early bird registration fee by 15th March 2020.

Oral presentations ...

Presentations should be 15 minutes long, followed by 5 minutes discussion. They will be grouped according to thematic areas. PowerPoint presentations are preferred.

Poster presentation ...

Posters will be mounted in the morning of the first day and exhibited during the entire Conference. The authors will have an opportunity to present the posters and discuss the topics during the poster session. Technical information about the size will be available on the web site of the Conference.
